The Project for Installation of Solar Panel System in Jericho Women Charitable Society

Today, June 30th, 2024, Mr. NAKASHIMA Yoichi, Ambassador for the Palestinian Affairs and Representative of Japan to Palestine, visited Jericho Women Charitable Society in Jericho Governorate to celebrate the completion of a project funded by the Government of Japan through Japan's Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP).

The Government of Japan extended a grant of USD 90,279 to Jericho Women Charitable Society to improve the educational environments for the students in the Jericho Women Charitable Society by installing solar panel system to provide sufficient power for running air conditioners in the classrooms.

Upon the completion of the project, about 900 people who use the society's facility will be directly benefit.

In his speech, Mr. NAKASHIMA emphasized Japan's firm commitment of supporting Palestinian people from human security perspective as well as the importance of implementing social and economic development projects needed for Palestinian communities.

Since 1993, the Government of Japan has extended its official development assistance to approximately USD 2.5 billion, to the Palestinians. GGP projects have been formulated in collaboration with the Palestinian Authority since 2010.
